



Stamps and Flags of Europe

Introduction: These geography activities will help pupils with European geography, languages spoken in some of the European countries as well as local to global geography. The wordbank below contains words that the pupils may not have come across before.

Geography Activity: Guess the name of each country on the map of Europe – fill in the answer on the blank stamp.

Find out what languages are spoken in the countries on the European map.

Do you know how to say hello in each language, write this in beside the name of the country. (See attached worksheet).

Geography Activity: Draw all the flags that represent you, your community and your family. For example, Europe, Ireland, Dublin, Na Fianna GAA Club, St. Patrick Athletic FC, Scouting Ireland troop etc.

If you were asked to make a new flag for Ireland what would it look like?

From the newspaper or a news website find a story about another country in Europe, what is the story about?
